



Nugget Nectar, Troegs (Hersey, PA)

Dry Hopped Imperial Amber Ale

A blend of recently harvested hops provides this ale with an explosion of pine, rasin and mango.

ABV 7.5% \$7.

Honey Barrel, Kentucky Ale (Kentucky) Honey Barrel Brown Ale.

The huge complex aroma is dominated by complimentary pine and resin notes. On the palate this aggressive but drinkable ale delivers with an array of citrus flavors highlighted by a bright subtle fruit character. Extremely well balanced, with the malt profile reminiscent of rye bread.

ABV 10% \$9.

Brawler, Yards (Philadelphia, PA) English Dark Mild Ale.

Malt forward and delicately hopped for a knockout flavor. Its smooth character, hints of caramel and toast, and remarkable drinkability define this ruby colored brew as a true session ale.

ABV 4.2% \$6.

Winter Solstice, Anderson Valley (California) Winter Warmer.

This ale boasts a deep amber color with hints of toffee, spice & caramel.

ABV 7% \$6.5

Dirty Bastard, Founders (Grand Rapids, MI) Scotch Ale.

Bold and powerful, dark ruby in color, complex in the finish with hints of smoke and peat paired with a malty richness, finalized with a good bit of hop attitude. This beer “ain’t fer the wee lads”

ABV 8.5% \$6.

Damnation, Russian River (Santa Rosa, CA) Belgian Strong Ale.

Extraordinary aromas of banana and pear with mouth filling flavors of sweet malt and earthy hops. The lingering finish is dry and slightly bitter but very, very smooth.

ABV 7.8% \$8.

Milk Stout, Lancaster (Lancaster, PA) Sweet Stout.

Traditional English style sweet stout. A bold, dark ale bursting with roasted barley dryness and mellowed by hints of chocolate and coffee.

ABV 5.3% \$6.

C.O.B., Free Will (Perkasie, PA) Coffee Oatmeal Brown Ale.

This strong brown ale has a delicious malty backbone with notes of caramel, brown sugar & graham cracker, added to the classic coffee taste.

ABV 8.3% \$6.5

Innis & Gunn Oak Aged, Wellpark (Edinburgh, Scotland) Strong Ale.

Aromas of vanilla and toffee, hints of citrus, with a malty, lightly oaked, palate. Deftly balanced and light in texture, soothing and warming in the finish.

ABV 6.6% \$6.75

Thomas Jefferson’s Tavern Ale, Yards (Phila., PA) English Strong Ale.

A powerful and complex golden ale. Yards recreated this recipe, employing honey, rye, and wheat, just like the beer Jefferson made at Monticello.

ABV 8% \$6.

Brown Shugga, Lagunitas (Petaluma, CA) American Strong Ale.

Dark amber ale with aromas of caramel, brown sugar, pine & citrus. Starts hoppy then finishes malty and warm.

ABV 10% \$6.25

Breakfast Stout, Founders (Michigan) American Imperial Stout.

This stout is brewed with flaked oats, bitter & sweet imported chocolates, Sumatra and kona coffees. A chocolate lovers dream.

ABV 8.3% \$8.5

Siberian Night, Thirsty Dog (Ohio) Imperial Stout.

Russian imperial stout aged for 11 months in bourbon barrels, yielding milk chocolate & vanilla.

ABV 11% \$8.

Three Philosophers, Ommegang (Cooperstown, NY) Abt/Quadrupel.

Cloudy dark amber under a nice thick tan head. Aroma is sweet with notes of dark fruit, clove, and roasted malt. Flavor is sweet still with strong presence of cherries among the Belgian malts. Medium bodied with carbonation and a light alcohol finish.

ABV 9.7% \$8.

George Washington’s Tavern Porter, Yards (Philadelphia, PA)

Brewed from George Washington’s own recipe, this porter uses molasses to produce rich, caramel notes and finishes with dried fruit on the palate.

ABV 7% \$6.

Liquid Bliss, Terrapin (Georgia) Chocolate Peanut Butter Porter.

Enjoy the “liquid bliss” of this chocolate & peanut butter fused porter.

ABV 6.7% \$6.5

Blithering Idiot, Weyerbacher (Easton, PA) English Barleywine.

Brimming with dark stone-fruit, as well as prunes, dates, figs, and all manner of dried fruits. On the malty side, without being overly sweet. The finish is warm and fruity, and begs for the next sip.

ABV 11.1% \$6.75

Virginia Draft, Bold Rock (Nellysford, VA) Cider. ABV 4.7% Crisp apple slightly sweet and refreshing. Clear, pale and sparkling.	ABV 4.7 %	\$6.
Hennepin, Ommegang (Cooperstown, NY) Saison. This hoppy, farmhouse style ale has a champagne-like effervescence with a crisp but light on the tongue finish. This beer serves well as an aperitif.	ABV 7.7%	\$6.75
Community, Free Will (Perkasie, PA) Kölsch. Clean and delicately balanced, with subtle fruit and malt flavor with a crisp dry finish.	ABV 4.8%	\$6.
Grand Cru, Rodenbach (Belgium) Flanders Red Ale (sour). Sweet, sour, and balanced. Pours clear reddish-brown as one would expect. Aroma is tart with fruit notes, cherry, vinegar, and grapes. Taste follows the nose, nice tart sour cherry with a hint of bread.	ABV 6%	\$9.
Liliko'i Kepolo, Avery (Boulder, CO) Belgian Style White Ale with Passionfruit. This island style witbier erupts with passionfruit and tropical aromas.	ABV 5.4%	\$7.5
Kasteel Rouge, Honsebrouck (Ingelmunster, Belgium) Fruit Beer. Pours a deep red with a quickly dissipating head of large bubbles. Distinct but mellow cherry aroma and a lovely toasted malt note. Well-balanced sweet cherry flavor, with a light malt background. Finish is a tart cherry, with dark fruits and a bit of alcohol.	ABV 8%	\$9.
White, Allagash (Maine) Belgian White Ale. Belgian style wheat beer spiced with a blend of coriander & curacao orange peel.	ABV 5.1%	\$7.
Oberon Ale, Bell's (Michigan) American Wheat Ale Mixing a spicy hop character with mild fruity aromas. A classic summer beer.	ABV 5.8%	\$6.5
Dreamweaver, Tröeg's (Hershey, PA) Hefeweizen. Combining four wheat types with Munich and Pils malts, noble Saaz hops, and a yeast strain that imparts a spicy, peppery, clove taste with a slight hint of bananas. A spicy unfiltered blast.	ABV 4.8%	\$6.
Franziskaner, Spaten-Franziskaner-Brau (Munich, Germany) Hefeweizen. Pours a cloudy yellow with thin creamy white head. Slightly sweet upfront and practically no bitterness. Notes of banana, cloves, wheat, honey, bread yeasts. Very well balanced.	ABV 5%	\$6.
Chimay Premiere, Chimay (Baileux, Belgium) Abbey Dubbel. Coppery color topped with a creamy head, gives off a light, fruity apricot aroma. The taste balance confirming the fruity nuances noticed in the fragrance and a light touch of bitterness.	ABV 7%	\$9.
La Fin Du Monde, Unibroue (Chambly, Canada) Abbey Tripel. The excellence of triple fermentation through a blend of special yeasts gives this malt beverage an exquisitely robust flavor of exceptional refinement. A floral bouquet; aromas of honey, spice, coriander and malt. Mild yeasty with a complex palate of malt, fruit and spice notes followed by a smooth dry finish.	ABV 9%	\$7.
Kasteel Triple, Honsebrouck (Ingelmunster, Belgium) Abbey Tripel. A strong blonde beer aged in brandy barrels in which both bitterness and the fruitiness of the hops make their presence felt. Subtle aroma with touches of fruit and impressions of malt, cloves and flowers. A balanced beer that is not too bitter.	ABV 11%	\$9.
Dubbel, Allagash (Portland, ME) Belgian Dubbel. A deep red color and a complex malty taste. The finish is dry with subtle hints of chocolate & nuts.	25oz. ABV 7%	\$18.
Finest Kind IPA, Smuttynose (New Hampshire) IPA. Classic east coast IPA featuring bright citrus aromas.	ABV 6.9%	\$6.5
Hotal Illusion, Blue Point (New York) IPA Award winning IPA blending hops in five different ways. This process allows the flavor to "burst" with a citrus punch.	ABV 7%	\$6.5
Vital, Victory (Downingtown, PA) IPA. Full of crisp & fresh fruity notes driven by American hops & German malts.	ABV 6.5%	\$6.
Fresh Squeezed, Deschutes (Bend, OR) American IPA. This mouthwateringly delicious IPA gets its flavor from a heavy helping of citrus and mosaic hops. Pungent orangey floral citrus aroma. Nice earthy, malty backbone with some fruit and mild fresh green hop fruity bitterness.	ABV 6.4%	\$6.25
Luponic Distortion (Batch 004), Firestone Walker (Paso Robles, CA) American IPA. Features a blend of six different hops. Aromas of pineapple, papaya & citrus lead to citrus & red grapefruit on the palette.	ABV 5.9%	\$7.
Hop Devil, Victory (Downingtown, PA) American IPA. "Bold, spicy and menacingly delicious." This IPA offers an aromatic punch and follows with a full-bodied finish.	ABV 6.7%	\$6.
